State and National Leaders to Discuss How New EJ Bill Sets Up Sweeping Nationwide Changes

A pioneering environmental justice law, which may serve as a framework for a national drive for environmental justice, will be the topic of an online panel discussion on Thursday, Sept. 2, from 10 a.m. to noon ET. The event is open to professionals in the field as well as the public.

The Zoom session, titled "New Jersey's Environmental Justice Law as a Potential National Model," is cosponsored by Enviro-Sciences (of Delaware), Inc., a multimedia international environmental consulting firm, and the National Association of Environmental Professionals (NAEP), an interdisciplinary organization dedicated to developing the highest standards of ethics and proficiency in the environmental professions.

During the two-hour panel discussion, national and state leaders dealing with this issue will examine the current environmental justice landscape, where the environmental justice movement will be five to 10 years from now, and if the New Jersey model - considered by many as the "gold standard" - can work nationally.
