HBCD and What the CDRA Does

Cyclic Aliphatic Bromide Cluster (HBCD) is a chemical no longer used in foam panel insulation, and even when it was used, it was a small part of the total number of foam panels manufactured. Today, the best estimates are that foam panels containing HBCD make up about .015 percent of the C&D waste stream, making it virtually non-existent.

That isn't stopping the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency from regulating the chemical after they determined the material is hazardous.

What materials do you recycle? Can you describe the volume and types of incoming materials you process?

As an equipment supplier to the industry, I don't have a recycling facility. However, most of my work in C&D has been with mixed C&D recycling facilities ranging from 25-100 tons per hour. Starting with primary
