Four Named to CDRA Board

Dan Horton is the president of ASR. From his Midwestern roots as a roofing distributor branch manager and after 19 years in the building materials business, Dan left his director position at IKO Industries, based in Toronto, ON, to establish Asphalt Shingle Recycling (ASR) Systems. His vision was to create a roofing industry circular solution. In 2010, one year after founding the company, he attracted investors and established ASR Holding Company. He developed a more efficient, mechanical recycling method, which separates asphalt

roofing shingles, made of six raw materials, into two streams of reusable materials, with zero waste. This novel process was recognized by the US Patent and Trade Office awarding Dan with three utility patents, a fourth patent (design) disclosing recycling equipment design, and a fifth (utility) patent disclosing centrifuge extraction. The two raw materials, defined as less than 500-micron asphaltic limestone powder (ALP) and recycled roofing granules, are a part of various circular economy solutions.

Andrea Johnson is the CEO of van der Linde Recycling, Container Rentals, and Pete's Pick-Up, all of which provide waste and recycling services in the Central Virginia region. Andrea has a B.S. in Business Administration from U.M.U.C and is a licensed waste operator in VA. She has committed herself to a life of service, first as a military wife of 23 years and now to the environment, her community, and the amazing team she works with





Heather Schuler has been in the marketing industry for more than 25 years. She has been the Marketing Specialist for General Kinematics since 2019. GK is an equipment manufacturer and turnkey system integrator in Crystal Lake, IL. Heather's focus at GK has been on tradeshow strategy and developing relationships with media partners and trade associations.
